Transportation in the 16th Century. Also carriers with covered wagons carried goods and sometimes passengers. However when possible people preferred to transport goods by water. In 1769, another Frenchman named Nicolas Joseph Cugnot attempted to adapt steam engine technology to a road vehicle and the result was the invention of the first automobile. The heavy engine added so much weight to the vehicle that it was ultimately too impractical for something that had a top speed of two and ½ miles an hour.
